The prisoners, a former French officer, who has thoughts of overpowering the guard and trying to escape, an Austrian nobleman, who had left Vienna in disgust after the Nazi occupation, and other French citizens (artist, actor, electrician, etc.) are caught up by the frenzy of fear and rumor of occupied France.
